


















## **NEXTDOOR HOMEPAGE**



NextDoor is a digital platform destined to motivate and support neighbours and community workers in reducing isolation of elderly people.

It is an innovative tool that maps the local available resources in order to increase their accessibility and visibility for the elderly and their social networks.

The NextDoor platform has been thought to benefit seniors, but it was designed to be used by any other users, such as neighbours, relatives, as well as by community workers and organizations who offer useful services or support for the elderly.




The platform is available in multiple languages: English, German, French, Spanish, Italian, Portuguese and Romanian. You can select the language in the upper-right corner of the platform.






## **SERVICES MAP**

You can browse the map by moving it or type keywords in the search bar to find social services, volunteer organizations, homecare services, health services, leisure activities, delivery shops, pharmacies or more.



Clicking on a pin on the map will show you further details about the selected organization or service.




#### Resources
